



We are a **Beekeeping Exporting Group from the Province of Santa Fe, Argentina**, composed of Cooperatives from different locations within the province. We develop and promote honey production based on strict quality protocols guaranteeing traceability throughout the product chain from the hive to the end user.

We join together to define a qualified product export offer, showing an annual production volume of about 2500 tons of conventional and organic honey in order to increase our presence in international markets. Our Export Offer includes bulk honey and value-added products as conventional, organic, and flavored fractionated honey producing delicate results on the most sophisticated consumer palates.

We produce other honey-based products such as craft beer, and we do teamwork aiming by-product development to satisfy demands from different foreign markets and market segments; such as wax, pollen, propolis, among others.



Our honeys are available mainly in Germany, United States of America, Canada, Spain, England, Italy, Japan, Czech Republic, among other markets that we continuously incorporate in our destinations.

Apiculture outstands in agricultural production in Argentina, our country is one of the main honey producers worldwide and it is well-known by its outstanding quality.

According to the Argentine Beekeeper Registration (RENAPA, Registro Nacional de Productores Apícolas), there are about 1561 Registered Beekeepers in the Province of Santa Fe with 408 264 hives (in 5359 apiaries), 7000 of which are certified as organic production. Production in the Province supports 15 % of the Argentine honey volume for export and it is the second largest producer in the country.



We progress together with consumption trends for natural and healthy products getting healthy benefits which demand distinguishable honeys and sustainable by-products.

Our different types of honey according to differentiated pollination and production areas focus on the following flower species:

Meadow: Trifolium repens; Heliantheae; Helianthus annuus; Cichorium intybus; Carduus sp.; Brassicaceae; Medicago sativa; Melilotus albus; Echium plantagineum; Cirsium sp.; Sphaeralcea bonariensis.

Forest: Geoffroea sp.; Vachellia caven; Acacia sp.; Schinopsis balansae; Baccharis sp.; Prosopis sp.; Senegalia gilliesii; Acacia praecox; Prosopis.

Islands: Enterolobium contortisiliquum; Salix humboldtiana; Tessaria integrifolia; Erythrina crista-galli; Victoria cruziana; Pistia stratiotes; Eichornia sp.; Canna indica; Polygonum punctatum; other minor species.
